What are cookies

Cookies are small pieces of text sent to your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the website or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the website more useful to you. Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

How Future of Work uses cookies

Future of Work uses third-parties cookies to report usage statistics of the website.

Google Analytics

Through our website a cookie is placed from Google, as part of their "Analytics" service. We use this service to get reports on how visitors use our website. Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is legally obliged to do so, or if third parties process the information on behalf of Google. We have no influence on this. We have not allowed Google to use the obtained analytics information for other (Google) services. The information that Google collects is anonymized as much as possible. The information is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google states that it adheres to the Privacy Shield principles and is affiliated with the Privacy Shield program of the US Department of Commerce. This means that there is an appropriate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.
